# Circular craft centre - at one location

Here, the five building blocks of a circular craft centre come together in one place.

#### 1 Recycling point

Here you can drop off items and materials that are reusable or repairable. Non-reusable items are recycled, sometimes after disassembly.

### 2 Social circular organisation

Reusable items go to the social circular organisation. They are checked, cleaned and sold in the shop.

#### Repair

Products that no longer work are repaired here. Often you can also visit the Repair Café yourself to have your own items repaired.

#### 4 Social domain

Repair

People from the social domain work throughout the circular craft centre. They face barriers to employment or receive social support.

#### **6** Education

The circular craft centre works together with schools. For example, by offering lesson materials about circularity to primary schools and internships for students.
